Primary Purpose of Committee:

Encourage all members of WRRR to become comfortable and competent coxswains; ensure that coxswains are good stewards of WRRR equipment, practices and policies

Scope – Responsible for:

1. Develop and provide coxswain training and feedback
2. Assist the Club Manager in the recruitment of coxswains
3. Work with WRRR Program Committee to meet the coxswain needs of the various programs
4. Work with Club Manager and WRRR Board to ensure compliance with Safe Sport policies
5. Work with WRRR Board to set Coxswain pay scale and compensation

Goals – For 2016:

1. Continue and expand the Coxswain training program, including on the water training and evaluation
2. Provide on-going opportunities for WRRR members to improve their coxing skills

Authority – Specifically Authorized to:

1. Develop and implement coxing clinics, including beginner, advanced, and on-water training
2. Own, edit and distribute Coxswain manual
3. Work with other committees (e.g. Communications) to determine best practices for overall rower education as it relates to coxing, boat handling, and boat safety
4. Hire coxswains with the input of employment, program standards and club manager
5. Spend committee-related funds as allocated in the annual budget
